Their advocacy helps ensure the children are safe, have a permanent home and the opportunity to thrive. The work done by these volunteers is life changing for the children they represent.

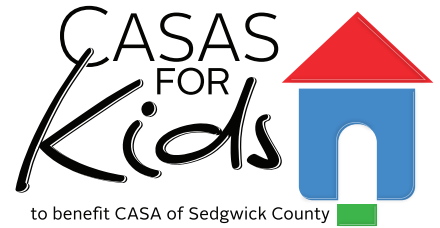

BID ON ONE OF 2 PLAYHOUSES

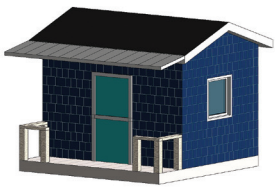
Two playhouses will be auctioned at a special fundraising event **"Wine, Whiskey and Whimsy"** on February 26, 2022.

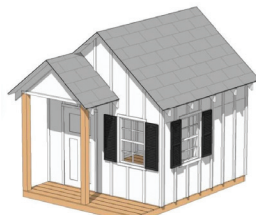

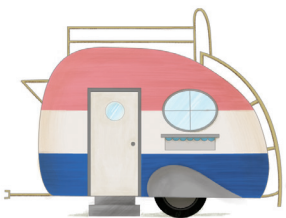
